Bell Wheels - For Sale **by sealed bids taken on the night**

Each of the bells sit within a large wooden rope wheel which is attached to the bell headstock. The rope goes around the outside of the wheel and when the bell is rung the wheel rotates causing the clapper to strike the inside of the bell. The bell wheels have an approximate diameter of 4ft to 7ft. A bell wheel could be made into a decorative garden feature or it could be simply displayed on a wall and would be a permanent reminder of our historical bells.
