

COVID 19 Guidelines

Mini Angels

- A contact list of all those attending must be kept in accordance with the government guidelines for 21 days & in accordance with the Parish Safeguarding rules if applicable.
- Consideration should be given for those who wish to continue Social distancing.
- Parent/guardians should bring toys etc. for their own children, which should not be shared. They should also bring a blanket or similar for the child to sit on.
- Parent/guardians must bring their own drinks & snacks if required which must not be shared
- Prior to the start the toilets should be checked to ensure that there are paper towels and soap present. The water heater switch (Next to the toilet light switch) should be switched on.
- Every effort should be made to avoid any unnecessary contact with any areas outside of the chosen setup area
- If the toilet has been used then all handles, taps and light switches must be cleaned (light switches should not be cleaned using the spray).
- Any other light switches and door handles that have been used must be cleaned
- Dirty cloths must be thrown in the black bag bin.
- Toilet water heater must be turned off
- The cleaning log must be completed with the name of the person(s) doing the cleaning and signed
